

1 - New and Improved Website




We've given our website a fresh look with volunteer support from Taproot Foundation!

2 - Nourishing Maui: Okoa's Farm Store Expansion Project



We are thrilled to partner with 'Oko'a Farms as they continue to broaden their reach and impact for Maui.

Their shift from farmers markets to brick-and-mortar last June has *quadrupled* access of local, organic produce and value-adds for our community. What's more, the store has served as an incredible showcase of local produce and products from over *SEVENTY* vendors.

This summer, **Dr. Dean** provided a loan to 'Oko'a so they could purchase the neighboring unit to the current store. The expansion will enable them to grow into the fixture for the community they've always envisaged.

The addition will include hot food selections, feature even more delicious local provisions, provide more space for customers...and did we mention they will finally have space for an office!?

We're always looking for passionate individuals to join our team.


And now, as we begin to deepen our roots as a charitable fixture on Maui, we are looking to bring on a Volunteer Coordinator that can maximize our reach.
